Introduction

Project Middle China (PMC) allows the people from New Zealand to be the Culture Ambassadors living and experiencing in middle China - Henan, where the Chinese civilization began.

While these Culture Ambassadors are in Henan, they will spend some of their time teaching Western culture and English language to the Chinese students, and the rest time experiencing the rich culture and lives in Henan.

The organizers are New Zealand China Friendship Society, Zhengzhou Youxie (Zhengzhou People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries) and New Zealand Chinese Youth Federation.



Quick Facts

Duration: 10 months (excluding summer and winter holidays)

Base City: Zhengzhou, Henan Province, China

Activities: Teaching English. Learn about Chinese Food Culture, History, Tea Culture, Mandarin, Taichi Practising, Short trips to other cities in Henan, etc.

Teaching Work: Max 20 hours per week

Pre-requisite: native or near-native English speaker holding a Bachelor's degree in any subject. If your degree is not related to language education, you will need to have a TESOL certificate (more details in later session).

Students: Options from pre-school kids to university students

Salary: varied with work experience and receiving schools

Overview of Henan

Henan is the birthplace of Chinese civilization with over 3,000 years of recorded history, and remained China's cultural, economical, and political center until approximately 1,000 years ago. Numerous heritages have been left behind including the ruins of Shang Dynasty capital city Yin and the Shaolin Temple. Four of the Eight Great Ancient Capitals of China, Luoyang, Anyang, Kaifeng, and Zhengzhou are located in Henan. Shaolin Kung Fu (Chinese: 少林功夫; pinyin: Shàolín gōngfu), is among the oldest institutionalized styles of Chinese martial arts; it originated and was developed in the Buddhist Shaolin temple in Henan.
